

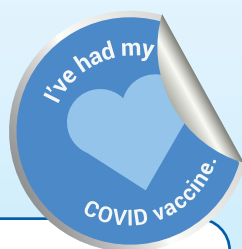
COVID-19 VACCINATION PROGRAM

Our program removes guesswork from the vaccination process. We manage vaccine campaigns in a cost-effective and clinically sound manner while complying with all regulatory requirements. WorkCare's occupational health physicians oversee the program, and our nurses are trained to administer specific vaccine types. Services include:

- Vaccine distribution planning and supplies
- Identification of recipient employees/populations
- Scheduling and administration
- Vaccination verification, recordkeeping and reporting
- Education on vaccine efficacy and safety



OPTIONS: Self-Acquired Vaccine or Pharmacy Model

Company Acquires Vaccine – WorkCare Manages Administration

When partnering with WorkCare to administer vaccine to employees, you have three options if your company plans to self-acquire vaccine, can maintain cold-chain shipping requirements and safely store doses: 1) Self-Acquired Comprehensive Solution; 2) Self-Acquired Hybrid Solution; 3) Traditional Onsite Solution.

Option 1 – Comprehensive*

- Fully trained and screened temporary staff to administer shots
- Administration, observation and emergency response
- Web-based scheduling tool
- Reporting as required by local, state and federal agencies
- Administrative assistant(s) for days(s) of vaccination event
- Consulting Medical Director oversight, as needed

The following applies for these products based on vaccine preparation and administration times:

- Pfizer-BioNTech – 10 hours/nurse
- Moderna and Johnson & Johnson - 20 hours/nurse

** Per-dose-administered cost includes all services listed.*

Option 2 – Hybrid

- Onsite staff supported by WorkCare
- Staff event in addition to onsite staff
- All other services same as Comprehensive option

Option 3 – Traditional Onsite

- WorkCare trains and supports onsite staff
- Standard onsite rates apply based on existing agreements
- Includes scheduling, supplies administration and reporting at per-dose rate

Company Does Not Acquire Vaccine – Uses Pharmacy Network

If your company does not plan to acquire vaccine, WorkCare partners with a national network of pharmacies to manage vaccine acquisition, distribution and administration.

Option 4 – Community Pharmacy Enhanced Services Network (CPESN)



WorkCare has partnered with CPESN to provide access to 3,340+ participating independent pharmacies in most states. This flexible option includes:

- Local pharmacy scheduling and reporting
- In-pharmacy events for less than 100 shots per site
- Onsite events for more than 100 shots per site (WorkCare onsite support optional)**
- Local pharmacy bills administrative fees directly to PBM or medical insurance
- Educational material on vaccine efficacy and safety
